Sir,

This has reference to the your above referred letter for the proposal to allow to receive treated effluent, total 3.86 MLD from the member industries, to the Vapi CETP, for further treatment and discharge, in place of 3.86 MLD domestic waste water.

And whereas, you have upgraded CETP to achieve the norms.

And whereas, you have submitted list of 91 industries along with their existing discharge as per GPCB CC& A, proposed discharge by the respective industries and total discharge of respective industries.

And whereas, after detailed discussion during various meeting held at Vapi as well as Gandhinagar, and as you have assured for the necessary compliance and in no case quantity of effluent from the CETP shall not exceed 55 MLD.

Keeping in mind above and performance of the CETP in recent past, Gujarat Pollution Control Board hereby principally agreed to allow CETP to receive total 3.86 MLD industrial water from the 91 industries only, for treatment and final disposal with following conditions:

The quantity of waste water shall not be exceeded then 55 MLD as permission granted in CC& A (even after receiving 3.86 MLD).

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- (ii) CETP shall ensure to maintain inlet and outlet norms given in the CC& A.
- (iii) CETP shall issue new certificate henceforth, to the 91 member industries having details like, existing water consumption and generation of domestic and industrial waste water, proposed water consumption and generation of domestic and industrial waste water.
- (iv) Concerned 91 industries shall obtain CTE amendment and CC&A amendment from the Board.(Copy attached herewith the letter of Vapi Green Enviro Limited dated 01.09.2017, along with list of 91 industries, which is freeze now).

CETP shall start to receive waste water only after CC&A amendment issued by the Board. CETP shall maintain record for the waste water received with the quality and quantity as mentioned in the referred list and submit to the Regional office and Head office of the Board at every 3 month interval.

(v) This trail permission is granted to the CETP for the six month time period from the date of issue of this letter. The Board will review the norms of Inlet and outlet of the CETP as a whole after six month and further decision will be reviewed accordingly.

This letter is issued after approval of the competent authority of the Board.
